ITEMS MARKED * MUST BE OBTAINED FROM UNIFORM4KIDS

1	School Blazer (Rented from School, not from Uniform4Kids). These will be provided to new pupils after their arrival at school and monitored frequently to see if your son needs a bigger blazer. If you ever feel that your son's blazer is getting too small, please make Miss Thorpe aware and she will consider changing it.	
2*	School Ties (Royal Blue for pupils in Forms I-III. Pupils in Forms IV and V earn a Red tie when they become a Senior Chorister, so pupils in Form IV should return with a blue tie initially.)	
1	Long quilted navy wax jacket (Uniform4Kids are no longer to supply this item. We have, however, found an alternative supplier HERE due to how attached the boys are to their wax jackets!	
1*	Navy hat for winter (optional)	
2 prs	Grey Trousers, long (available from Uniform4Kids or another supplier of your choice as long as they are a similar colour)	
2prs	Grey Shorts (optional) (available from Uniform4Kids or another supplier of your choice as long as they are a similar colour)	
5 prs*	Grey ankle socks (available from Uniform4Kids or another supplier of your choice as long as they are a similar colour)	
5 prs*	Dark grey socks, long (if shorts worn) (available from Uniform4Kids or another supplier of your choice as long as they are a similar colour)	
2*	Long sleeved grey V-neck jumpers	
5	White shirts, long sleeved (available from Uniform4Kids or another supplier of your choice as long as they are a similar colour). Ideally choose shirts that are non-iron because we wash and tumble dry uniform	

5	White shirts, short sleeved (optional) (available from Uniform4Kids or another supplier of your choice as long as they are a similar colour). Ideally choose shirts that are non-iron because we wash and tumble dry uniform

1**	Royal blue and gold Polo Shirt (NB: Some families may choose to purchase two if their son is likely to wear this as a casual item)	
1 pr**	Royal blue and gold long games socks – Westminster Abbey Choir School style	
1 pr**	Royal blue and gold games shorts (NB: Some families may choose to purchase two if their son is likely to wear this as a casual item)	
1**	Royal blue and gold hoodie	
1*	Navy blue tracksuit top (microfibre with logo) (Optional as an addition to the hoodie)	
1*	Matching navy-blue jogging bottoms (Optional – pupils must either have navy blue base layer bottoms to go under their shorts, or tracksuit trousers to go over their shorts when it is cold.)	
1*	Navy base layer top (Optional)	
1*	Navy base layer bottoms (Optional – pupils must either have navy blue base layer bottoms to go under their shorts, or tracksuit trousers to go over their shorts when it is cold.)	
1 pr	Shin pads Winter & Lent Terms only	
2 prs	Trainers suitable for sports; one to be kept exclusively for indoor use e.g., sports halls (non marking soles), and the other for use outside.	
1	Gum Shield (for use in hockey during the Lent term – pupils in all year groups) PLEASE NOTE these must be moulded before coming to school and in a named case or bag.	

SUMMER TERM ONLY

1*	Plain white V-necked cricket sweater – long or short sleeved (only required for those in 1 st XI when playing matches)	
1*	Cricket shirt – cream colour – short sleeved (only required for those in 1 st XI when playing matches)	
1*	White Cricket trousers (only required for those in 1 st XI when playing matches)	
1	Plain white cricket/sun hat	
1	Bottle of sun cream	
1	Pair of swim shorts (they do not need to be a particular style, this is for them to wear when going to Shadwell when kayaking and stand up paddle boarding)	

1	Pair of water shoes or old trainers that can be worn for kayaking and paddleboarding at Shadwell. Open-toed shoes or crocs are not suitable.	
1	Set of long sleeve and long bottom old clothing that can be worn at Shadwell and get wet. (This is also used for climbing so must be long sleeved and legged.)	
1	Optional Wetsuit (for use at Shadwell)	

GENERAL

2	White vests (Optional)	
5 prs	Underpants or boxer shorts – not red, please, as the colour runs in the wash	
2 prs	Pyjamas	
1	Dressing Gown (towelling or fleece is good if your son is less competent at drying himself!	
1 pr	Bedroom slippers	
1 pr	Classic design plain black shoes – NOT trainer style, no patent or flashing lights. Velcro shoes are allowed and are preferred if your son is not yet confident with doing laces.	
1 pr	Shower Shoes e.g. crocs, sliders, flip flops that can be worn around the bathroom in a wet environment.	
1	Shoe cleaning kit (preferably NOT quick shine) for pupils in Forms II-V only	
1 pr	Gloves Winter Term (optional)	
1	Hair brush (optional) NB: All boys must have something suitable for their hair type in order to tidy their hair.	
2	Combs (optional) NB: All boys must have something suitable for their hair type in order to tidy their hair.	
1	Toothbrush and 2 tubes of toothpaste	
1	Deodorant (if used). Please ensure that stick or roll-on deodorant is provided, <u>not</u> spray deodorant.	
2	Face flannels – name taped and with a hook for hanging (optional)	
1 pr	Small nail clippers	
2	Duvet covers – colourfast, machine washable and <u>name taped at corner</u> (matching pillow cases optional)	
2	Bath towels (not bath sheet) – name taped at corner and looped at middle of long side for hanging. Not red – see above.	
1	Oyster Zip Card for travel on bus and underground. All boys irrespective of age require one at school. This should be handed in on the first day of term	
1	Music case for instrumental music	
1	Pencil case containing items listed on page 15, appropriate to the age of your son	
1	Large suitcase (or trunk)	
1	Named reusable water bottle	
1	Pair of headphones suitable to be plugged into the computer using a USB port.	
Casuals for weekend use: Please do not send more than this as space is limited and it can be difficult for boys to manage their space. Additional clothing will be sent by Matron if necessary.		
2	Shirts	
2	Jumpers/fleeces	
1 pr	Indoor trainers/light shoes	
2 prs	Trousers/jeans	

Whilst it is tempting to provide your son with more clothing than it outlined on this list, particularly for casual wear, drawer and wardrobe space is limited and it gets confusing for your son, so please refrain from doing this. Additional items will be sent home.

NB Please note that we do not expect boys to have full cricket whites although some may choose to wear them for cricket lessons during the Summer Term.

To be kept at School:

- NHS number and Medical History notes
- 2 dozen Name tapes (**woven**). These can be ordered through UNIFORM4KIDS
- 2 dozen self-adhesive labels for items such as stationery

Glasses: Boys who wear glasses should have a spare pair at school (to be given to Matron).

Any medication must be handed **directly** to Matron Miss Thorpe or Assistant Matron, Miss Adcock. In their absence, Miss McNeely can receive medication. If you are bringing a new medication into school for your child, **you must complete a Permission Form for Administering Medication outlining what the medication is and how it should be administered.** This is available to be downloaded directly from the school website.
